What We Do

We fulfill our vision through the following three major programs:

Outreach Program

- Youth Community Centers: a place where youth can develop their talents and hang out in a safe space.
- Charity Club: a youth-led initiative that improves sanitation in communities.
- School Clubs: an after-school program that develops academic, health and leadership skills.





Education Program

- Leadership Academy: an intense and practical leadership development program for a period of one year.
- Vocational Institute: handson training in skills like tailoring, hair dressing, carpentry, mechanics, shoe making, catering and welding.
- Early Childhood Development Center: a learning center for 3-10 year old children whose parents are unable to afford formal education.

Family Intervention Program

- Chadashah Teenage Pregnancy Center: a refuge for young mothers and their babies that provides housing, food, medical care and vocational training.
- Foster Care: a network of partner organizations and foster families to ensure every child has the opportunity to live in a safe home.
- Mentorship: pairing a youth with a responsible, driven and God-following adult to provide social, economical, and spiritual wisdom.
- Medical: our community clinic provides subsidized health care services to our youth and the community. We also run regular medical camps in various communities.
